Itinerary

Thurs Oct 11 - depart US for Kathmandu. You are responsible for booking your own airfare, arriving in Kathmandu by late afternoon on Friday October 12. Don't worry! We can offer flight suggestions to help you meet up with fellow team members.

Fri Oct 12 - Kathmandu

Arrive Kathmandu and enjoy dinner out with the group.
Overnight at [Hotel Manang](#).

Sa Oct 13 - Kathmandu

Visit the Nazarene church with Father Rinzi Lama, the "Father of Anglican Church in Nepal".
Hear an overview of Christianity in Nepal from Fr. Rinzi Lama.
Visit the Berea church with Pastor Nopu.

Su Oct 14 - Kathmandu

Take a City Tour.
Visit the sites of [Swayambunath](#) and [Durbar Square](#).
Learn about Buddhist and Hindu influences in Nepal.

Mo Oct 15 - Kathmandu

Visit Living Hope, the church of Father Prem Tamang, an Anglican Priest in Kathmandu.
Visit Pastor Daniel at Revival Church and see the community and school that serves the poor in the slum of Danaseri.
After lunch, transfer to the airport for the flight to [Pokhara](#).

Tue-Fri Oct 16-19: Two Options for your visit to Pokhara

Pokhara Local Engagement Option: Ministry to the marginalized in the mountains

For four days in Pokhara, participate in several ministry activities. Work alongside other Christian workers in the refugee camps. Educate on the importance of clean water and hand out water sanitizing units. Tutor children in English and Math at a local kindergarten. Visit the slums and encourage the women there with prayer and fellowship. Meet various church partners to understand what it means to be a Christian in this part of the world in a context very different from our own.

Annapurna Trekking Option: Spiritual Retreat in the Mountains

Spend four days hiking part of the Annapurna Circuit, Trek approximately 5-6 hours each day, along routes with spectacular panoramic views of the Annapurna Massif. Each night the group will stay in lodges along the route. Trekkers will rejoin rest of the group for dinner in Pokhara on Friday Oct 19. Elevation on the treks will reach 10,500ft and will be strenuous in nature.

Sa Oct 20 - Pokhara

Sunrise visit to Sarangkot viewpoint of the Annapurna and Fishtail mountain ranges.
Attend Maranatha church.
Worship at the Maranatha church in Pokhara.
Fly back to Kathmandu in time for dinner.

Su Oct 21 - Kathmandu

Enjoy a final day in Kathmandu as a rest day.
Visit the markets, etc.
Fly out in the afternoon for arrival back in the US on Monday October 22.
