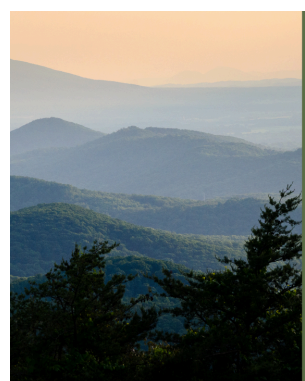

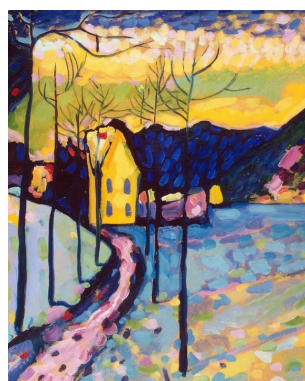
Digital Detox
