I invite you call to mind God's ultimate reality, God's unstoppable love for you, God's infinite wisdom, and the fact that life doesn't end here.

You might call to mind anything in your life right now that is hard for you or that you don't understand.

Once you've a sense of God's loving gaze upon you, and are gripping your faith with a bit of a tighter grasp, go ahead and pray.



"God you have created me to do You some definite service. You have committed some work to me which You have not committed to another. I have my mission. I may never know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next. I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons. You have not created me for naught. I shall do good; I shall do Your work. I shall be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth in my own place, while not intending it if I do but keep Your commandments. Therefore, I will trust You, whatever I am, I can never be thrown away. If I am in sickness, my sickness may serve You, in perplexity, my perplexity may serve You. If I am in sorrow, my sorrow may serve You. You do nothing in vain. You know what You are about. You may take away my friends. You may throw me among strangers. You may make me feel desolate, make my spirits sink, hide my future from me. Still, You know what You are about."
